SHELTER GUIDELINES

1. Absolutely no smoking of any kind is permissible on campus.
2. Pets will only be allowed to enter the shelter if they are in a fully enclosed crate. Guide dogs in harness and muzzled are permissible. Please don't put us in a position that we must refuse your pet's entry into this facility.
3. Only handicapped and elderly persons with walking disabilities may park and enter through the basement entrance. All other attendees must enter through the upper parking lot. Please reference the map on the bottom of this page.
4. No parking under the awning except for loading and unloading purposes.
5. Once inside the shelter you must remain in the shelter and not loiter on any other part of the campus, including parking lots. If you leave the confines of the shelter, it will be presumed by shelter staff you are leaving the property entirely.
6. Each person in the shelter is expected to conduct themselves in

a manner that does not interfere, or cause problems for the other occupants. There is a zero tolerance for profanity, threats, or violence of any kind.

7. Parents are responsible for always controlling the actions and whereabouts of their children. We encourage you to bring drinks, snacks, and something to entertain children.
8. Each person is responsible for cleaning up their trash and spills. Guests are responsible for their own property. BBC is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.
9. All occupants must obey the shelter staff instructions. Anyone not complying with the staff's request may be asked to leave the campus.
10. The shelter is equipped with Wi-Fi. Choose BBC (Public). The password is: bbchg.org
The shelter is also equipped with a cell phone extender, which allows you to make and receive calls within the shelter. Televisions are

installed to watch the weather live.
